

Saute onions in butter until brown around the edges. Add boiling water and beef bouillon. Add Worcestershire sauce and flour. Stir well. Simmer for 1/2 hour, stirring occasionally. Pour into soup bowls and sprinkle with Parmesan cheese. Serves 6


Greetings from the outdoorsmen. November is upon us and so too is hunting season so please be careful out there and respect the law.


Has anyone else felt the shift in the weather? October was a good

Tangier Past Masters' Shrine Club



#### Official Call for Elections Thursday, December 14, 2017 Tangier Shriners, Oasis of Omaha, Desert of Nebraska

The annual elections of Tangier Shriners will be held on Thursday, December 14, 2017 at 2823 S. 84th Street, Omaha Nebraska at 7:30 p.m. No later than 9:00 p.m. the annual election will start. Tangier Temple will elect seven Divan members, a Trustee for a four year term, Representatives to the Imperial

Council and Central States Shrine Association, and any openings which may occur in the interim.

#### Members must have their 2017 Dues Card for admission to this meeting

FROM IMPERIAL BY-LAWS (IOWA CORPORATION)

#### Article 25

- 325.4 When Elected. Each Temple must elect its Officers and Representatives at its annual meeting in January unless it's bylaws allow the election to occur at the temple's stated meeting in December.
- 325.5 Ballot. Election of officers shall be by separate written ballot and by a majority vote of those present and voting. A blanket ballot is prohibited.
- 325.6 Time of Election. Nominations must commence no later than 9:00 p.m. and when that hour arrives all other business must cease and none may be transacted until the election is concluded.
- 325.7 Other Officers. The Temple may elect such other officers as its Bylaws provide.
- 325.8 Nominations. Candidates for office and Representatives must be placed in nomination from the floor.
- 325.10 Representatives.
  - (a) Where a Temple elects more than one Representative, all candidates must be balloted for on one written ballot.
  - (b) Each member voting must vote only for the total number of Representatives to be elected, otherwise his ballot cannot be counted as a vote.
  - (c) A majority of those present and voting is necessary to elect each Representative.
  - (d) Only those candidates who receive a majority vote shall be declared elected.
  - (e) Successive written ballots must then be taken in the same manner on other candidates until all Representatives are elected.
  - (f) If more candidates receive a majority vote than the number of Representatives to be elected, then those receiving the greatest number of votes shall be declared elected.
  - (g) Blank ballots or ballots containing any markings other than the name of a candidate nominated from the floor are not votes and are not to be considered for any purpose.

#### 325.11 Election Regulations.

- (a) A candidate for an elected office in a Shrine temple may print, publish and circulate during the year he is seeking the elected office, a resume consisting of his educational background, his vocational history, and his Masonic and Shrine record. Except as provided in the prior sentence, the printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets, email or other devices, by a unit, club, Noble, or group of Nobles, suggesting, recommending, opposing, or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the temple is prohibited.
- (b) The expenditure of money for gifts, favors, or entertainment on behalf of a candidate for elected office is prohibited.
- (c) For any violation of (a) or (b), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble, and he may declare the election of the officers void and order a new election.
- (d) At least one week prior to the annual meeting or any election, the temple Recorder shall mail to each member a notice thereof containing this section.





Sustaining a spinal cord injury (SCI) can be a frightening, overwhelming experience. A spinal cord injury can affect every function of the body.

The treatment team includes a variety of surgeons and other physicians, nurses, therapists, therapeutic recreation specialists, psychologists, social workers, and dieticians.

Innovative therapy efforts include body-weight supported manual treadmill training or robotic treadmill training with the Lokomat, a device that automates movement therapy and improves the efficiency of treadmill training in patients with neurological movement disorders, such as spinal cord injury. Both of these therapies provide weight-bearing opportunities and can help stimulate muscles and build strength and stamina. Some of our hospitals also offer robotic assisted gait training via the ReWalk exoskeleton system.

In addition to therapy, exercise and activity-based rehabilitation, including aqua therapy, pet therapy and adaptive sports, is emphasized. These activities build strength and stamina and increase social interaction, confidence and independence. Some of the hospitals also offer specialty camps emphasizing aspects of health, fitness and independence.


