

Since July 24, the Chanters have been practicing on Mondays with our eyes to possible performances this summer.




Greetings from your Tangier Shrine Corvette Club.





Rather than an article, this month we take a look back through some of the years of Tangier Shrine.

1921

The Masonic Home was established and located at 22nd and Davenport Streets. It opened March 1921 and took in boys from the Juvenile Court as well as homeless boys.

1933

William B. Whitehorn, born and raised in Omaha, died suddenly while on vacation in Chicago, age 63. He had been clerk of Municipal Court for fifteen years, and Recorder of Tangier Temple since 1925. His brethren mourn. All of our sympathies turn to Mrs. Whitehorn in this hour. Burial was from the Scottish Rite Cathedral in Omaha, September 2, 1933. In the emergency created by the death of Recorder Whitehorn, the Potentate has appointed Hugh T. Cutler as acting recorder of Tangier Shrine.

1947

Noble J. Gibbs, a member of "B" Patrol closed his law office and went to the Philippines for the military government in connection with prosecuting Japanese war criminals.

1949

Tangier Shrine Temple joined with Sesostris Temple and held a joint picnic at Linoma Beach August 24.

The Imperial Session (75th Diamond Jubilee) was held in Chicago. Over 60,000 were in attendance. Tangier had a special train with over 300 Nobles attending.

1950

Fall Ceremonial held November 4, 1950. More than 60 candidates were initiated into Tangier Shrine Temple. Among the group was General Curtis E. LeMay.

1957

Three new units were organized on Potentate Bing Grunwald's watch; The Legion of Honor, Corvettes and the Mounted Patrol. Two of the three are still active today.

1960

The Mobile Nobles were created with an initial group of 10 traveling Nobles.

1963

The 5,000th Tangier Shrine Temple Noble Joseph Akin, Omaha Police Officer, joined Tangier.

1977

Tangier Temple obtained a liquor license and opened the Bagdad Lounge on February 11.

1981

The Hayawan Patrol (Nobles dressed as Animated Characters) was established on January 5.

1986

The Road Runners came into being and continue to execute on our mission to provide our unique brand of care to the Children/Families of our community.




