His services were held at the Second Unitarian Church in Omaha on November 1, 2023.

We will be doing pot luck again, with the Hillbillies supplying the meat again this year. We are asking you to bring a horse duver, side, or dessert to share.



Thank you to everyone who participated and ordered Holiday Greens for our annual fund raiser and for making it a success.



History that is Tangier



Smiling Sam Dresher Jr. 1878 - 1947 Potentate 1937

The year was 1864 and the Civil War was entering its third year. Samuel Dresher Sr. was 19 years of age and living with his family on a farm in Pennsylvania. With no end to the war in sight, and the outcome uncertain, Samuel enlisted on February 18, 1864. He would serve in Company F of the 51st Pennsylvania Infantry for the remainder of

the war, being discharged on July 27, 1865.

After the war, Samuel returned to farming in Pennsylvania and married Helen Maury in 1870. The first two of their six children were born in Pennsylvania. In 1877 Samuel moved the family west, settling in Bedford, a small town in Taylor County Iowa. Here he would farm, for a time, and then pursue carpentry, finally becoming a contractor in Bedford and Omaha.

It was in Bedford, on November 12, 1878, Samuel Dresher Jr. joined the family. He was the third child, joining brothers Albert and Charles. Two sisters, Louisa and Elsie, and a brother James, would soon follow.

Samuel Jr. received his education in the rural schools of Bedford and Taylor County through at least the eighth grade. As was common at the time, he left school and embraced adulthood and all the responsibilities that came with it. He and his brothers inherited the work ethic, tenacity, and entrepreneurial spirit of their father. These qualities would serve them well throughout their lives.

Samuel Jr. arrived in Omaha, Nebraska when he was 18, in 1896. Approximately two years later, he and brothers Albert, Charles, and James, established the Dresher Brothers Cleaners and Dyers as well as Dresher the Tailor. Their journey as self-employed business

owners may have been in its infancy, but a successful business was taking shape.

It wasn't all work and no play for Samuel. With the business on solid ground, Samuel began courting Ms. Mayme Kulha of Ravenna, Nebraska. They were married on December 24, 1908. Though they would not have biological children of their own, the couple adopted Franklin Henry Kulha (1919-2011), their nephew. Franklin was the son of Mayme's brother Henry Kulha and his wife Vlasta (Krainik). Franklin grew up in the cleaning business and ultimately owned Dresher's Dry Cleaning until his retirement in 1973.

Whether the cleaning of clothes, rugs or other household furnishings, the tailoring of made to order suits and clothing, or the cold storage of Furs, the brothers spared no expense ensuring that their commercial establishments maintained the most modern equipment. When industry equipment was not up to the standards of the brothers or could not be found, it became the task of the Dresher's mechanical genius, Samuel, to invent and build what was needed. By 1916 Samuel had no fewer than 15 cleaning inventions.

While focusing upon their cleaning, dyeing, cold storage and tailoring businesses, the brothers diversified. They held real estate interests in Omaha, as well as land and oil leases in Wyoming. The brothers, along with T.J. O'Brien, P.T. McGrath, Bert Murphy, Charles Garvey, Frank McGinn, Jack Mulvihill and Art Swanson began drilling operations around 1920. They had brought in water wells, but in 1925 their hard work was rewarded with an oil strike.

In 1922 the A.A.O.N.M.S Imperial Session was held in San Francisco, California. A contingent of Tangier Shriners made the journey to enjoy business and ceremony and a bit of relaxation. Mayme and Franklin attended along with Samuel but decided to extend their visit with friends and relatives in California. Samuel would return to Omaha alone on July 8.

As he sat in the club car of the eastbound Santa Fe Train No. 4, he was talking with another man and lighting a cigarette. As they were approaching Burton, Kansas, the train ran into an open switch and crashed into nine gasoline and oil cars situated nearby. It was as if a great wind had struck the train, said Samuel. He lost consciousness. When he came to, he was pinned by both legs under debris. He pulled his legs free and tried to stand but his right leg was severely injured. Samuel and several other injured persons were taken to hospitals in Hutchinson, Kansas, where he would spend the next several days.

Samuel returned to Burlington Station on July 12, 1922, and was met by many of his fellow Concord Club members. As he, and the stretcher he occupied, was lifted through one of the train windows, Samuel was serenaded by a chorus of, Old Sam Dresher Ain't What He Used to Be.

As dedicated as Samuel was to his brothers and the businesses, he was equally dedicated to his obligations to Mizpah Lodge, the Scottish and York rites, Tangier Shrine Temple, the Sixteen and Concord Clubs and various other civic and masonic groups. He was Director of Tangier for many years and became Potentate in 1937. Little known was the fact that Samuel played Santa to hundreds of children each holiday and provided treats and gifts at his own expense. He was always accompanied by his trick dog Curley.

After retiring, Samuel made his home on a small farm near Irvington, Nebraska. Returning to his roots, he was devoted to the care and maintenance of his livestock and grounds.

Samuel laid down his working tools on August 13, 1947, age 68 years 9 months and 1 day. His was a life well lived. Well done, good and faithful servant.

This is the most important business meeting of the year! Official Call for Elections Thursday, December 14, 2023 Tangier Shriners, Oasis of Omaha, Desert of Nebraska

The annual elections of Tangier Shriners will be held on Thursday, December 14, 2023 at 2823 S. 84th Street, Omaha Nebraska at 7:30 p.m. No later than 9:00 p.m. the annual election will start. Tangier Temple will elect seven Divan members, a Trustee for a four year term, Representatives to the Imperial Council and Central States Shrine Association, and any openings which may occur in the interim.

Members must have their 2023 Dues Card for admission to this meeting

FROM IMPERIAL BY-LAWS (IOWA CORPORATION) Article 25

- When Elected. Each Temple must elect its Officers and Representatives at its annual meeting in January unless its bylaws allow the election to occur at the temple's stated meeting in December.
- 325.5 Ballot. Election of officers shall be by separate written ballot and by a majority vote of those present and voting. A blanket ballot is prohibited.
- Time of Election. Nominations must commence no later than 9:00 p.m. and when that hour arrives all other business must cease and none may be transacted until the election is concluded.
- 325.7 Other Officers. The Temple may elect such other officers as its Bylaws provide.
- 325.8 Nominations. Candidates for office and Representatives must be placed in nomination from the floor.
- 325.10 Representatives.
 - a) Where a Temple elects more than one Representative, all candidates must be balloted for on one written ballot.
 - (b) Each member voting must vote only for the total number of Representatives to be elected, otherwise his ballot cannot be counted as a vote.
 - (c) A majority of those present and voting is necessary to elect each Representative.
 - (d) Only those candidates who receive a majority vote shall be declared elected.
 - (e) Successive written ballots must then be taken in the same manner on other candidates until all Representatives are elected.
 - (f) If more candidates receive a majority vote than the number of Representatives to be elected, then those receiving the greatest number of votes shall be declared elected.
 - (g) Blank ballots or ballots containing any markings other than the name of a candidate nominated from the floor are not votes and are not to be considered for any purpose.

325.11 Election Regulations.

- (a) A candidate for an elected office in a Shrine temple may print, publish and circulate during the year he is seeking the elected office, a resume consisting of his educational background, his vocational history, and his Masonic and Shrine record. Except as provided in the prior sentence, the printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets, email or other devices, by a unit, club, Noble, or group of Nobles, suggesting, recommending, opposing, or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the temple is prohibited.
- (b) The expenditure of money for gifts, favors, or entertainment on behalf of a candidate for elected office is prohibited.
- (c) For any violation of (a) or (b), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble, and he may declare the election of the officers void and order a new election.
- (d) At least one week prior to the annual meeting or any election, the temple Recorder shall mail to each member a notice thereof containing this section.




