Thank you for your support of Nile, the comradery and fellowship, and for remembering Tassles!



### Tangier Temple Membership 5,000 Strong

Greetings Nobles and Ladies,

As we have learned in previous articles, Gustave Anderson, Henry Akin, Victor White, Charles Dietz, Jeff Bedford, James Gilbert, Elbert Duke, C.B. Finch and a handful of others were given dispensation to form Tangier Temple in April of 1889. Their commitment, focus and determination ensured that Tangier Temple would be formed and in June of 1890 the Imperial Council granted Tangier Temple its Charter.

The original admission fee was \$25.00, equivalent in purchasing power to about \$806.51 in 2023. To put it into perspective, in the late 19th century the average income for an American worker in an urban area was about \$400 or \$500 yearly.

When Tangier Temple was originally formed, no dues were assessed. Rather, an assessment was levied when it became necessary to defray expenses.

The annual report in December of 1890 showed Tangier Temple enjoying a membership of 211 Nobles. In March of 1910 the membership had grown to 1,263 Nobles. Fast forward to 1959 and outgoing Potentate Henry Pedersen was boasting of a membership including 4,506 Nobles. Tangier Temple had a lot to be proud of and it would get better.

The below article appeared in the Omaha World Herald in May 1963 shining light on a significant milestone for Tangier Temple. In 1963, Potentate Frank Jerome Given had the privilege of presiding over a Spring Ceremonial Class that would welcome its five thousandth member.

### Shriners March and Feast, Prepare 5,000th Candidate.

"Shriners from Tangier Temple staged a parade in downtown Omaha Saturday afternoon, feasted on roast pig and prepared to initiate their five-thousandth candidate.

These events were part of the temple's Spring Ceremonial, an all-day affair at the City Auditorium Arena and Music Hall. Candidate No. 5000 was Joseph H. Aken, 308 South Fiftieth Street, a city policeman. He was one of 146 candidates offered for initiation.

Candidates must symbolically cross hot sands for initiation. The hot coals over which the pigs were roasted represented this part of the ritual.

The parade featured the traditional Cycle Patrol, Shrine Clowns, and, for the first time, a baby elephant in a convertible. Seventeen units participated.

An evening banquet will finish the celebration. About 14 hundred Shriners are expected."

While Noble Aken may have received a bit more attention given his distinction, the class included other Nobles of which you are no doubt aware. Past Potentate 2003 James "Jim" Parks was a member of the spring class of 1963, as was Barry Kuhl. Noble Kuhl was Past Chief of Staff, Noble Rob Kuhl's father.

During the ceremonial festivities, each member of the 1963 Spring Ceremonial Class was given a "5000" pin to mark the membership milestone and special permission was given to each member to adorn their fez with this pin. Noble Rob Kuhl has loaned his father's fez to Tangier and the fez, along with the 5000 pin and other artifacts and photos can be seen in the display case for the month of February.

Joseph Hamilton Aken was born May 11, 1926 and laid down his working tools April 30, 2007. He served his country as a Corporal in the U.S. Marine Corps. and as a Sergeant in the U.S. Army during WWII and the Korean Conflict. After his military service, Joseph would become, and retire as, an Omaha Police Officer. He was preceded in death by his wife Joyce who had served her country in the Navy during WWII and was survived by his four children.




