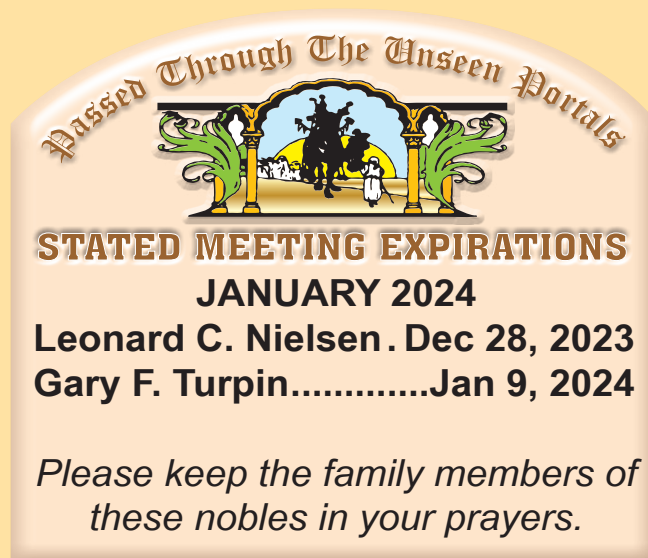

## Hospital Float


