



Trunk or Treat was a great event. We saw some great costumes. Great event for the kids and parents alike.




As I type this up, I am spending my last day in Alaska

Our unit meets on the second Tuesday of the month in the lower level of Tangier and any Noble is welcome to attend if interested in learning more about our unit.


