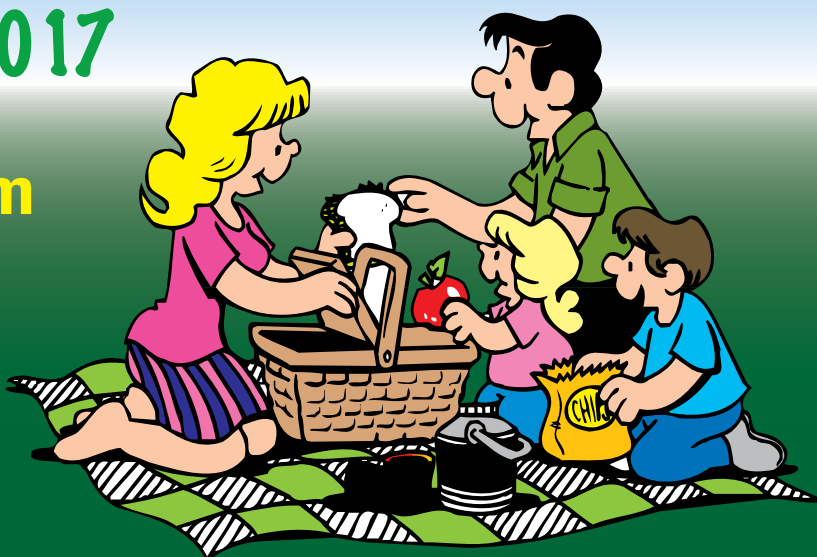

We have a Friendship dinner June 15th. Bring a friend and share with them the fun they can have being a Shrine Mason.

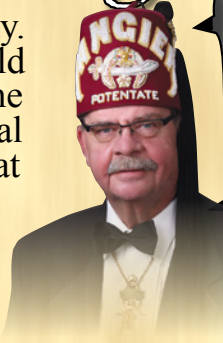
The Pote's Golf Outing is Friday, June 30. We always have a lot of fun and we raise money for the Tangier Transportation Fund.

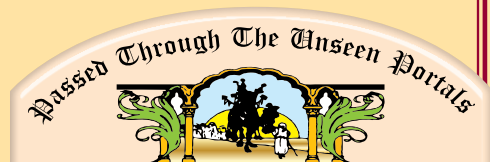

## Arbor Shrine

Arbor Shrine Club would like to thank everyone that purchased onions for our fundraiser and everyone should have received their order. If anyone has a problem with the onions, please contact Melton at 402-269-456 so the problem can be addressed.

Here is the parade schedule for Arbor Shrine Club for June and July: June 24th is Weeping Water with a 9:00 am line up; July 4th is Ralston with a noon line up; July 8th is Syracuse with a 10:00 am line up and July 29th Syracuse Otoe County Fair with a 4:00 pm line up.

Here is a general tip for onions. To chop an onion without it "getting away" cut it lengthwise in half from root to stem; peel. Place the flat cut surface down and dice lengthwise. One medium onion will make approximately 1/2 cup of chopped onions.

June's onion recipe is Grandma's Sweet Onion-Sausage Casserole: 5 No. 1 onions, sliced; 12 Ritz crackers, crushed; 1 lb sausage meat, browned and drained; 1/2 teaspoon salt; 1/4 teaspoon seasoning salt; 1 can Campbell's Cream of Mushroom Soup; 1/2 cup cheddar cheese grated; 1 small jar pimento pepper. Put onions in the bottom of a 12" x 17" Pyrex dish. Add Ritz crackers, and then sausage meat. Add a layer of onions, cream of mushroom soup, salt and seasoning salt. Sprinkle a layer of cheese and pimento. Bake in preheated oven at 400 degrees for 1 hour. Enjoy!

## Women's Auxiliary

As was promised last month, I have the report from Faye Daniels, the representative from the Auxiliary to the General Auxiliary: "We have several changes to the items that we can donate to the patients at Shriners Hospital For Children – Twin Cities as mandated by the State Board of Health and the Hospital Accreditation Board. The hospital can NO longer accept toiletries, such as those we accumulate from our various hotels stays, or stuffed toys from private collections, such as beanie baby collection, holiday bears, etc. Even though they may not have been "played with", if they were stored, the hospital cannot accept them. All toys, stuffed toys, books, etc, in other words, everything we send MUST be brand NEW.

A major concern for the General Auxiliary is the fact that monetary donations have decreased by 8% this last year. We had to tap into our savings to cover the commitment of \$252,433 for just the wheelchair fund, so we need to encourage financial donations as well as all other donations.

One of the items that the hospital does not want is hand knitted or crocheted blankets. The hems and fringe on that type of blanket get caught in the wheels of the chairs and is not safe. The fleece blankets seem to work much better. This year the Hospital has requested \$100,000 for the wheelchair fund and \$10,000 for needed upgrades to the Parents Accommodation Center which needs new beds as the current ones have been well used by our families. They have yet to determine specific needs.

Tangier received a very nice kudo from the husband of the receiving chairwoman. Whenever the box is marked Tangier, Mr. Anderson says great, I don't have to do a thing with this box. I told them about our Nobles that sort through all the tabs and the treasures that they find. Of course I told them that we delivered coffee and dessert to them for their work."

I don't have a lot to add except keep those tabs coming. Also any monetary donations given to Tangier Auxiliary go directly to the General Auxiliary to be used at the Twin Cities Hospital, the only hospital in the Shrine system that has an Auxiliary.

Be kind to one another and I will talk with you again next month.

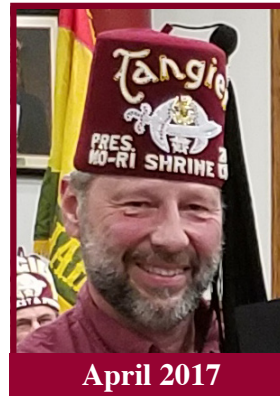

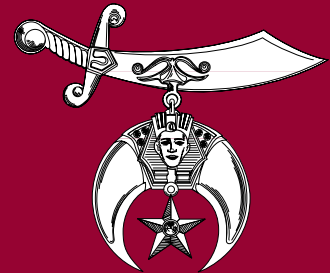

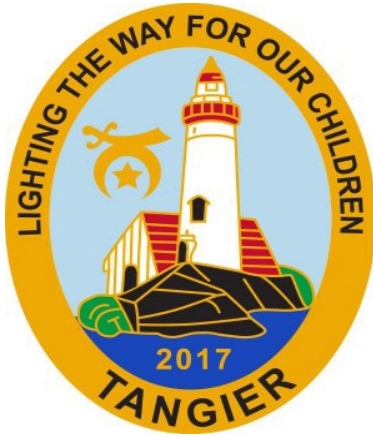

The following list details the current means by which a Tangier Shrine Noble may earn points towards receiving either a medallion and/or diamond or ruby jewels for a medallion, once presented. This list is consistent with the guidelines set forth by Shriners International in Tampa, FL. While it is subject to change, suitable notification will be given when or if changes are made. It is important to note that the burden of proof lies with the Noble seeking a medallion or jewel. A Shrine Medallion Award request form has been designed and is available at the Tangier Shrine office, the Samsar, or from the leader of each unit or club. Any Noble desiring to be considered for a medallion or jewel shall complete the form and submit to the Samsar or Tangier Shrine Office. Any additional documentation, where required, shall be the responsibility of the Noble.

### General Award Program

Blue Lodge Top-Line Signer	100 Points
Shrine Top-Line Signer	250 Points


The following list is the progressive order in which the medallion, colored ropes, and jewels will be awarded:

First 1000 Points:	Tangier Shrine Medallion / Green Rope
Second 600 Points:	1 <sup>st</sup> Diamond
Third 600 Points:	2 <sup>nd</sup> Diamond
Fourth 600 Points:	3 <sup>rd</sup> Diamond / Yellow Rope
Fifth 600 Points:	4 <sup>th</sup> Diamond
Sixth 600 Points:	5 <sup>th</sup> Diamond / Red Rope
Final 800 Points:	All Rubies

In each case of Top-Line Signers, verifiable records must be obtained by the Noble seeking the award. In those cases involving the Shrine, a simple computer records check will generally verify the required information. However, in the case of Blue Lodge Top-Line Signers, it shall be the sole responsibility of the Noble to obtain an original letter on respective Blue Lodge letterhead signed by the Lodge Secretary. The letter shall contain the following: Name(s) of the Brother(s) and the date(s) Raised to a Master Mason. Such letter will be attached to the aforementioned Shrine Medallion Award request form and will be submitted to the Tangier Shrine Samsar or office for appropriate action.

All questions concerning the Shrine Medallion Award Program shall be addressed to the Tangier Shrine Samsar. In the event of disputes or unsupported documentation, the Samsar, in consultation with the Tangier Divan, shall make the final decision in such matters.

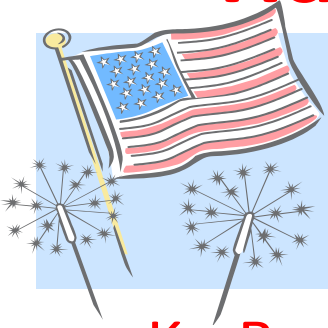

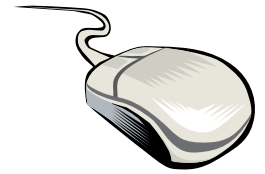
